The main goal of the project is to increase the labour market success of graduates of geographical studies by means of innovation of the study programmes. The innovation is aimed at implementation of 3D modelling and virtual reality issues to courses of territorial planning and regional development.

We will modernize the study background, lecturers will undergo the special training, new study materials will be created, and four new courses will be launched in a laboratory of the department called Centre for 3D modelling and virtual reality.

The exhibition with major outcomes will present the results of the project to public. One of the principal results will be the Methodical procedure of implementation of 3D modelling to geographical studies.

We will analyse the demands of institutions and companies which employ the graduates of geographical study programmes and, in turn, we will evaluate how the knowledge and skills of our students reflect these demands.

The innovation will involve the professionals from praxis in the educational process, and students will attend the scholarships in institutions of their potential employers.
